Colorado Springs – Colorado Springs City Council District 2 Candidate Timothy Dietz announced today that he is withdrawing from the race for District 2. Dietz issued the following statement:

“While it would be an honor and a privilege to represent the interests of the voters in District 2 on City Council, I have reached the conclusion that I cannot mount an effective campaign at this time. Numerous factors were considered in reaching this difficult decision with no single factor, standing alone, counseling a withdrawal other than the demands on limited available time for operating a campaign. For now, I can best serve the needs of the community by continuing to assist clients with resolving their legal issues together with exploring other community related services that do not require a full time effort.”

“I remain grateful for the opportunities to meet with voters and business leaders over the past couple of weeks as we engaged in healthy discussions that helped form my increasing understanding of the important issues to be tackled by City Council.
